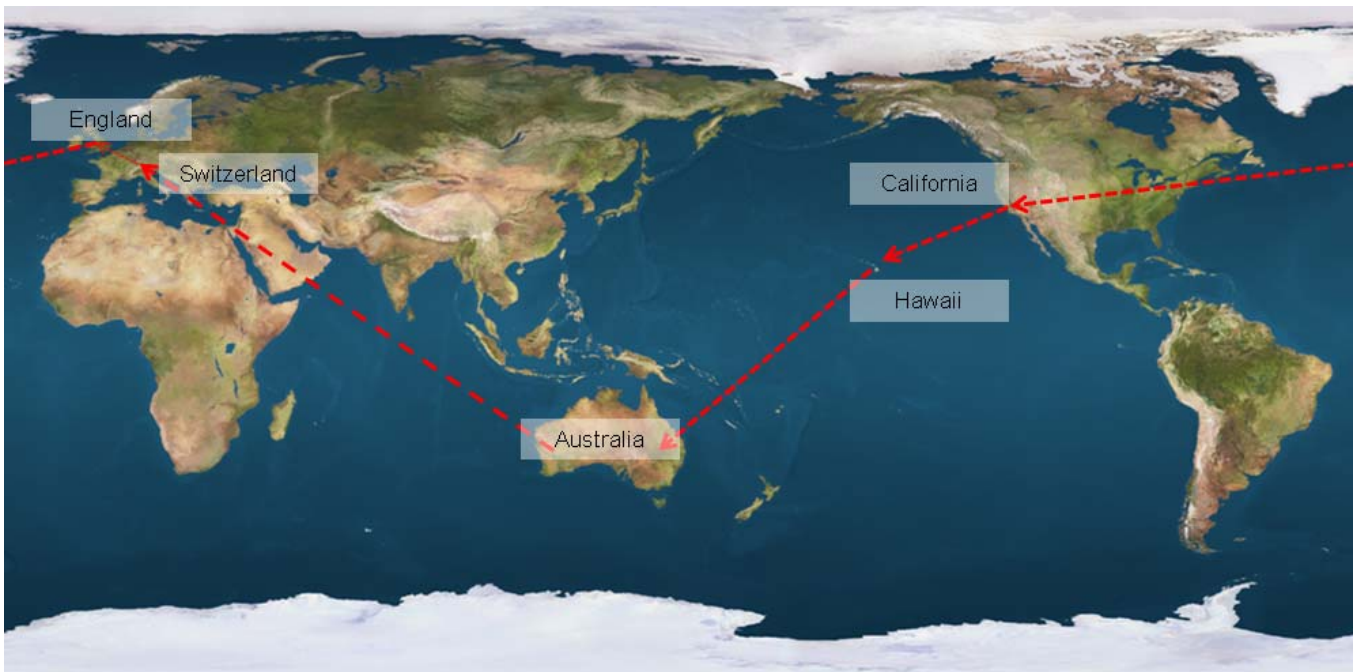

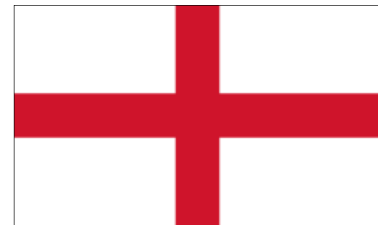

DAY 0	SCHAFFHAUSEN
morning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - I get up at 9 o'clock & go to the cafeteria of the youth hostel for breakfast - At the buffet, a boy talks to me → Tim, 20 years, from NY - We eat together & he asks me to join him for a trip through Schaffhausen - We take the bus, visit the Munot and the Rheinfall and have lunch
midday	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We're walking along the river Rhein. A man comes → invites us for a competition to win tickets for a voyage on the big ship. - Tim wants to participate → together with other participants, he has to swim across the Rhein and back. → I act like a cheerleader - He wins the two tickets
afternoon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We do the journey on the Rhein → beautiful weather & nature, I feel totally free - In Stein am Rhein: Walk through the city, ice cream at a cafeteria - We observe people jumping from the bridge → Tim wants it too - We search the train station & get the train back to Schaffhausen
evening / night	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - It's already 6 o'clock → back to the youth hostel. - I take a shower & dress up for the evening - 1 hour later we meet and go down to the city to the restaurant Falken. There are few places left & we have to sit down next to two girls. → We begin to talk together & see that they're tourists, too. They're very cool. - After dinner we decide to go to the clubs all 4 together. - Suddenly we lose the girls, but they have given me their numbers, so we find them in another club called Cuba. - At 3 o'clock we decide to go home → We're very tired and take the taxi - At the youth hostel, the doors are closed → We climb in through the window, alarm system goes off → Concierge is angry → As punishment, we have to clean all the toilets before we go to sleep. While cleaning, I'm thinking and laughing about the funny night we had at Schaffhausen. - I'm exhausted, wish Tim a good night and fall into my bed.

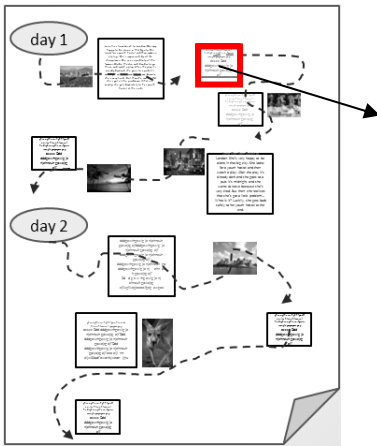




Example TEXT

This is an example for the texts you have to write and put on your poster. This text is just a little part, you should at least write 5 texts like that!



When I first open my eyes in the morning, I don't know where I am. But suddenly I remember it: I'm at the youth hostel of Schaffhausen! It's my first day and I'm very motivated to visit this beautiful city. As every morning, I make some exercises to keep my body fit and then I take a shower. It's 9 o'clock, I'm perfect in time for having breakfast.

Downstairs, there's a little buffet. I take bread, jam and a coffee. When I turn around to look for a table, I nearly crash into a young man. "Excuse me!", he says and introduces himself as Tim from New York. He suggests having breakfast together and I agree, because he seems to be really funny. "Do you already have an idea what you do today?", he asks me. "Well, not yet, but I absolutely want to see the city today!" – "Yes, that's what I planned! Let's go there together, it's going to be much funnier!" Why not!

After the breakfast, we go towards the bus station and wait for the bus. Tim tells me that he's staying in Switzerland to visit his aunt. "She lives in Zurich.
